The Tinker Field Research Grants **are not** to be used for advanced dissertation research; they are intended to provide graduate students with early experience conducting applicable field research in Latin America and the opportunity to develop independent research projects.

Latin American citizens enrolled at UC Santa Cruz are eligible to receive awards to conduct research in their home countries provided they have no previous field research experience in that country.
